Follow the steps below to guide you on how to setup Special Pricing.

- 1. Open Item screen > Pricing tab > Special Pricing tab.
- 2. A new line will be available to allow you to add a new special pricing information.
- 3. Pricing is setup per location. Select a location in the Location field.
- 4. Select the Promotion Type.

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- 5. Select Item UOM. To show how Unit Price is computed on this tab, see How Unit Price is computed based on UOM selected.
- 6. The Qty field will be updated by the Unit Qty setup of the UOM you selected.
- 7. In the Discount By field select either Percent or Discount.
- 8. Depending on the Discount By selected, fill in amount or percent in the Amount/Percent field.
- 9. The Unit Price will automatically be computed based on Retail Price/MSRP, Pricing Method and Amount/Percent selected.
- 10. The **Discounted Price** will automatically be computed based on Unit Price, Discount By and Discount Amount/Percent. To show how Discounted Price is computed based on Discount By selected.
- 11. In the **Begin Date** set begin date for discount/rebate to be in effect.
- 12. Leave End Date field blank. This means that there is no expiry date for the price.
