How to Add Item - Service Type

The Service type is used for services you charge for or purchase like consulting, labor, fees, etc. This item type does not track stock quantities and will be available for Sales and Purchasing transactions.

- 1. From Inventory module > click on **Items menu**.
- 2. The Search screen for Items will be shown. Click New toolbar button.
- 3. This will open a new Item screen.
