

How do I create Manufacturing Cells

1. Go to Manufacturing --> Manufacturing Cells/Machine/Pack Type
2. Click Tab Manufacturing Cell
3. Click on New

4. Enter the following in the Details tab.
 - > Name.
 - > Description.
 - > Location Name.
 - > Sub Location Name.
 - > Standard Capacity.
 - > Standard Capacity UOM.

8. Enter the Line Capacity
