

How do I create Manufacturing Process

1. Go to Manufacturing --> Manufacturing Process
2. Click on New.

3. Enter the Process Name in Detail tab.
4. Enter the Description in Detail tab.
5. Select the Type as Blending
6. Associate the Machine in Machine Detail section which you have created.

9. Select the TRUE or FALSE for the Attribute Name
10. Click on Save.
