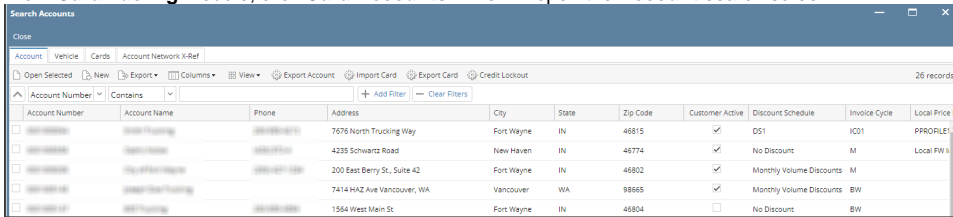


# How to Delete a Vehicle on Card Account

1. From **Card Fueling** module, click **Card Accounts**. This will open the **Account** search screen.




3. Click **Vehicles** tab. This will open the **Vehicles** tab screen.


4. Select a **Vehicle** row by clicking the appropriate checkbox. Click more checkboxes if multiple rows will be deleted.
