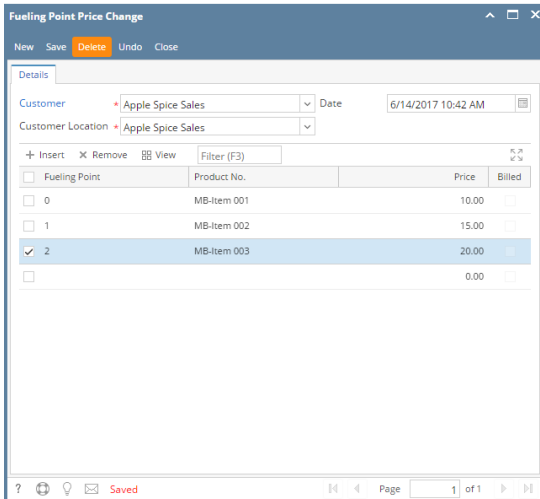


How to Delete Fueling Point Price Change

1. Open the Fueling Point Price Change you wish to delete.
