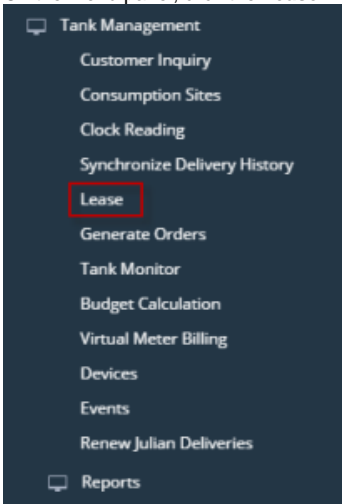
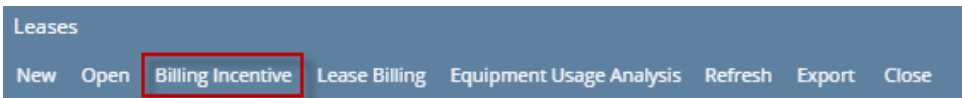


How to Create a Lease Billing Incentive

1. On the Menu panel, click the **Lease** menu. This will open the Leases screen.



2. Click on **Billing Incentive** toolbar button. This will open the Lease Billing Above Min Use Incentive screen.



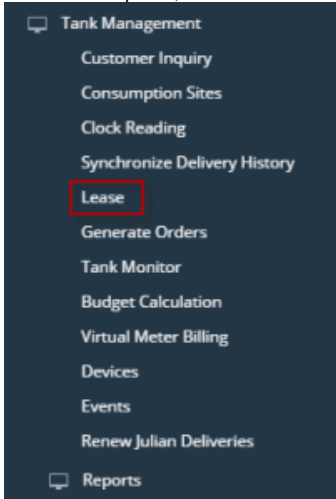
3. Select the **'Enable Lease Billing Above Min Use Incentives'** option to enable the grid area.

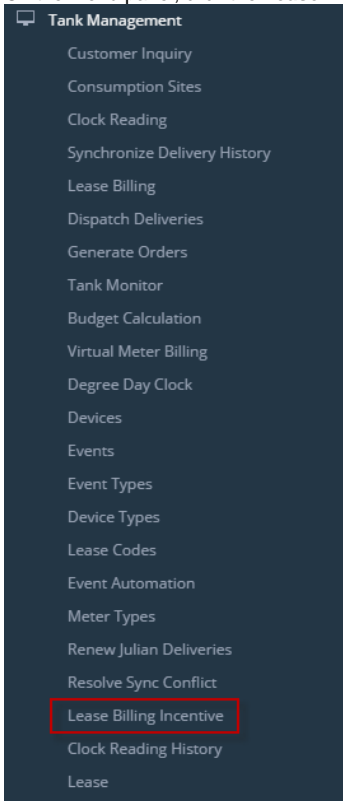

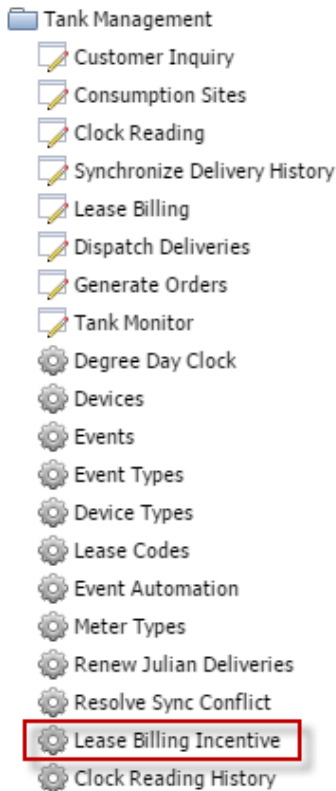
