2. iRely does not support an alpha-numeric chart of accounts
 - a. This style of account is difficult to use from a data entry perspective
 - b. The sorting and grouping function in the chart of accounts is not optimized for this pattern
 - c. Financial report design is more difficult with an alpha numeric pattern
3. iRely does not support the primary account being in a position other than the first position
 - a. Financial reporting has been optimized based upon having the primary account in the first position
4. The location should be in the second position of the chart of accounts
 - a. This is the Facility or location that you wish to create a profit and loss statement by
 - b. General Ledger accounts are defaulted to transactions based upon the location that a transaction is being processed for
5. The LOB or line of business is the third segment
 - a. This segment gives you the ability to auto assign accounts based upon the item category configuration
 - b. this will allow you to create a profit and loss by line of business in a simple manner.
