

How to Delete Canned Panel

1. Open a Canned Panel. Select copy that has not been activated yet.




2. Once opened, hit Delete button. Warning message will prompt.




3. Select Yes button. Canned Panel will be deleted.

When Canned Panel has associated user panel (canned panel copy):


1. Open a Canned Panel. Select copy that has been activated already.

 - b. Delete Canned Panel and Associated User Panel this will delete the canned panel and its associated user panel.




4. Select either of the options will delete the panel accordingly.








