
## How to Add Underscore row

The **Underscore row** is used to show a double underscore (or double rule) on Beginning Balance, Budget, Column Calculation, Credit, Credit Units, Debit, Debit Units, Ending Balance, GL Amounts, GL Trend, Percentage and Units columns in your financial report.

Follow these steps to add an Underscore row.
