WO Prod Staging lists out all the Blends which have already been staged i.e. reserved and are currently present in the Staging Location.

Accessing Blend Staging:

1. Go to Manufacturing-> Work order Staging

Menu	Usage
Create Pick Order	To Create an Outbound Order, user can select multiple orders to create one Outbound order
Undo	To undo last event
Refresh	To Reload the data
Close	To Close the manager screen

- 1. The manager screen displays all the blend work-orders which have the raw materials that are tracked in iStore.
- 2. User will be able to stage the raw materials in production staging unit.
- 3. When 'Open Pick Task' button is clicked, an outbound order opens. All the items of the blend sheet will load in the order. User will have to create tasks and complete the staging of the items.
