## **How to Display Panel on Dashboard**


Here are the steps you can follow on how you can display panels on your Dashboard:



- 4. From Dashboard menu, click the Panel Layout menu to open the Panel Layout screen.






By default, the **Panel Layout screen** displays one column only. However, you can change it depending on how many columns you would like to have on the Dashboard.

5. Click the grid combo box button to display the active Panels. Select the panel you want to display on Dashboard.




6. Click the Save toolbar button then Close. Panel will be loaded on the selected Dashboard.

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2. Enter the Tab Name from where you want to place the panel.




- 3. Click the Save then Close toolbar button.
- 4. From Dashboard menu, click the Panel Layout menu to open the Panel Layout screen.



By default, the Panel Layout screen displays one column only. However, you can change it depending on how many columns you would like to have on the dashboard.

5. Click the grid combo box button. The drop down will display the Panel Names with turned on Panel Access. Select the panel you want to display on dashboard.



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6. Click the Save then Close toolbar button. Panel will be automatically loaded on the dashboard on the selected tab.
